

# Toddler Home-School Day 1 – Colors

Choose one or more of these activities to do at home. I have linked to videos of the books being read as I don't expect you to have quick access to them. The activities are designed to be SIMPLE and to use items you already have at home.

<b>BOOKS</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Brown Bear Brown Bear, What do You See? <a href="#">Watch HERE</a></li> <li>- Elmer the Patchwork Elephant. <a href="#">Watch HERE</a> (older toddlers)</li> <li>- See <a href="#">more color book recommendations HERE</a>.</li> </ul>
<b>SINGING &amp; DANCING</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- So Many Colors to See – The Wiggles – <a href="#">Watch HERE</a></li> <li>- Awesome Rainbow Dance – Koo Koo Kangaroo – <a href="#">Watch HERE</a>.</li> </ul>
<b>SENSORY PLAY</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <a href="#">Color Changing Water Play</a></li> <li>- Color Sensory Bin (any sensory bin filler with the same colored cups, bowls, toys etc inside).</li> </ul>
<b>CRAFT</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <a href="#">Butterfly Painting</a></li> <li>- Regular painting or coloring (plain paper and paints or crayons)</li> </ul>
<b>LEARNING</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Color Sorting - sort pom poms, lego, duplo, toys or whatever you can find (extend this activity by using tongs / tweezers for older toddlers)</li> <li>- Color scavenger Hunt – see <a href="#">how to organize one HERE</a>.</li> </ul>
<b>OUTDOOR PLAY</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Nature Walk – talk about what colors you can see during your walk (even if it's only in your yard)</li> </ul>
<b>GAMES</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- I Spy (with colors) I spy with my little eye something that is RED..</li> </ul>
