

Toddler Home-School Day 6 – Bugs & Insects

Choose one or more of these activities to do at home. I have linked to videos of the books being read as I don't expect you to have quick access to them. The activities are designed to be SIMPLE and to use items you already have at home.

BOOKS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Very Quiet Cricket – Eric Carle – Watch HERE - The Very Hungry Caterpillar – Eric Carle – Watch HERE - Bugs Galore – Watch HERE
SINGING & DANCING & MOVEMENT
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Ants Go Marching One by One – Watch HERE - Bug'n Roll – Watch HERE - The Very Hungry Caterpillar Yoga – Watch HERE
SENSORY PLAY
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Make a bug sensory bin (use pipe cleaners or straws as 'bugs' if you don't have any plastic ones). - Caterpillar & Twig Sand Play - Go on a listening walk – walk very quietly and listen and talk about all the sounds you can hear. If you can't go outside at all, try using some nature sound recordings and talk about what you can hear. - Hide toy bugs in Jelly/Jello
LEARNING ACTIVITIES
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Very Hungry Caterpillar counting mats – get them free HERE.
CRAFTS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bug coloring in – get some free coloring in sheets HERE - Paper Plate Bee Craft
GAMES
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bug Hunt! Hide toys bugs (or other toys) around the house and then go on a hunt to find them all. Even more fun if you have a magnifying glass (or make a cardboard one).
